Professor Sir Peter Mathieson MBBS, PhD, FRCP, FRCPE, FMedSci, FRSE, FRSA was appointed Principal and Vice-Chancellor of the University of Edinburgh in February 2018. He is responsible for the overall operation of the University and represents the University at strategically significant meetings and events world wide. He is President of the Senatus Academicus and ex-officio, a member of the University Court. The Principal is nominated by the Curators of Patronage and appointed by the University Court. As Vice-Chancellor he confers degrees on behalf of the Chancellor HRH The Princess Royal. Please find below the expenses he has claimed, and any use of a corporate credit card, in connection with these duties.

Expenses are defined as those sums that were originally paid out by a member of staff and then subsequently reimbursed (for example through the e-expenses system). As some members of the Senior Leadership Team (SLT) also use a University credit card, these costs are also included. Please note that the category 'Other' comprises expenses which do not fit into the other four categories such as conference fees, Wi-Fi or e-SIM charges, and tourist taxes.
